Pro Career Highlights: Played with Gatos de Monagas in Venezuela in the summer of 2007, averaging 13.2 points and 5.8 rebounds in 38 games. Spent the 2006-07 season in France with Clermont, averaging 2.4 points and 2.6 rebounds in 14 games. Participated in NBA summer league with the Los Angeles Clippers in 2006.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Northeast Conference honors as a senior. Finished as the second leading scorer in Sacred Heart's Division I history with 1,289 career points. Also set school Division I records with 626 career rebounds and a 58.6 career field goal percentage. Named an Academic All-American by CoSIDA as a senior.

Senior (2006-07): Led the Northeast Conference in scoring (19.2 ppg), ranked fourth in rebounding (8.6 rpg), and ranked third in field goal percentage (.618, ranked ninth nationally). Started all 28 games. Scored 20 or more points 14 times and posted 12 double-doubles. Registered career-high 31 points on 11-for-15 shooting vs. Fairleigh Dickinson. Recorded 20 points and a career-high 16 rebounds vs. Mount St. Mary's. Tallyied 16 points and ten rebounds at Boston College. Scored 29 points at Albany. Shot 10-for-12 from the field in scoring 24 points vs. Central Connecticut State. Posted 22 points, 11 rebounds, and three blocked shots vs. Quinnipiac.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 10.5 points and 5.4 rebounds in 23.1 minutes a contest. Ranked tenth in the NEC in field goal percentage (.538). Started 19 of 27 games. Scored in double figures 13 times and posted three double-doubles. Recorded season-high 28 points on perfect 12-for-12 field goal shooting vs. St. Francis (Pa.). Registered 21 points and ten rebounds at Lehigh. Scored 21 points and grabbed nine rebounds at Robert Morris. Grabbed a season-high 11 rebounds in the season finale vs. St. Francis (Pa.).

Redshirt Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 10.6 points and 4.8 rebounds in 21.5 minutes a contest. Led the NEC in field goal percentage (.609). Started eight times. Scored season-high 20 points at Long Island. Tallyied 15 points and a season-high 11 rebounds at Albany. Recorded a season-high four blocked shots vs. Columbia. Scored ten points at Connecticut and at Boston College.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 4.3 points and 2.7 rebounds in 16.3 minutes a contest, appearing in three games with two starts. Scored a season-high six points vs. Yale and tallied five points and a season-high four rebounds vs. Northeastern. Granted a medical redshirt due to a back injury.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 6.5 points and 3.8 rebounds in 15.4 minutes a contest. Led team in field goal percentage (.560). Started 17 of 28 games, including the last ten games of the season. Scored in double figures six times. Registered season-high 19 points vs. Long Island. Recorded a double-double of 15 points and ten rebounds vs. St. Francis (N.Y.). Scored 15 points at Long Island.
